We are encouraged to be able to share with you that the Lionheart Children's Academy is successfully serving many families with great childcare made accessible through scholarships and childcare subsidies.

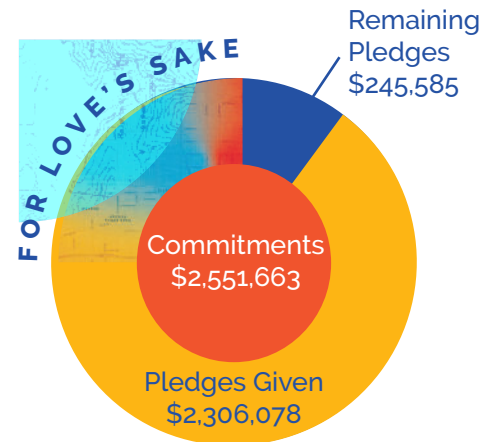
Enrollment is ahead of projections and, at the end of the second quarter, **40% of enrollees benefited from scholarships or subsidy funds.**
